Khasra No. 437 (17-09)

It belongs to DDA. Sh. Rajeev Kumar, Assistant Engineer, DDA met us at the spot and informed that TSS has already been done which needs verification from the Revenue Department, GNCTD. Since no positive resolution was coming forth between the two agencies/authorities as to time schedule, when the verification could be coordinated, the TSS plan, as conducted by DDA was handed over to the Revenue Department GNCT, for verification and the committee expects that the verification would be completed within a week and latest by 15.06.2023. Pertinent to add that we have been visiting this site for quite number of years but unfortunately have found no progress in its development. The condition is going from worse to worst. The water body was earlier witjh Revenue department, GNCT and has been transferred to DDA, as such DDA to submit the proposed action plan within a maximum period of 3 weeks and latest by 30.06.2023. DDA and Revenue Department, GNCT to explain separately as to what steps they have been taken for revival of this water body for the past 5 years. The report shall also be submitted

Thereafter physical meeting shall be fixed for progress and monitoring of this water body.







Basant Gaon/Basant Nagar
 Khasra No. 334 (10-14), 376 (03-09) and 514 (06-02)

We have been standing at Basant Gaon (Mandir) for half an hour School. Neither DDA nor Revenue Sanskriti near Department, GNCT is able to trace the water body, though the water body exists in the revenue records and finds mention in the list of water bodies to be surveyed today. The list was circulated couple of days ago with the request to the authorities to look into the records and trace the water bodies. Fortunately, we met villagers (one of whose name is Mr Sadanand - the resident of more than 60 years) who have categorically stated in front of the officers of DDA and Revenue Department, GNCT that the place where we are standing a huge Johar existed. We also found a large area of open land lying vacant at site,

The authorities are requested not to shift the burden on each other but to see to it that the water body gets revived. The authorities are once again requested to look into their own records/records filed before the Hon'ble High Court and other notings and submit the report within 3 weeks only along with relevant noting/records at email

The condition of the water body is pathetic. There is no water. No catchment as well. At site it was found that the water body was being converted into some other use (appears to be private). It has to be ascertained how these structures have come up and under whose authorities and under whose permission. Strangely, despite ordesr of the Apex Court no heed is being paid to protect the water body rather the issue has been diverted. It is also reported by DDA that while handing over the water body to DDA three structures were not handed over 1) a room (in which tubewell exist) 2) Bijli Ghar and 3) Dhalao. The dhalao can be moved outside and tubewell room can be handed over immediately. As regard Bijali Ghar proceeding be initiated for its vacation.

Coming to the development of the water body what is the course of action to be adopted by DDA be brought on paper and the said Action Plan be submitted to the Committee within a period of 3 weeks and latest by 30.06.2023 along with relevant noting/records at email — wivekkumartandon@gmail.com, tandonadvocates@gmail.com, thereafter physical meeting shall be fixed for progress and monitoring of this water body.

The water body was handed over to DDA in 2003. What steps have been taken from 2003 the date of handing over to DDA be also brought on record.


Khasra No. 78 (08-05)
