



1.	<b><u>Issapur:-</u></b>	
G. No. 661	<b>Kh. No. 148(6-13)</b>  It belongs to BDO. It is dry and very dirty. Sewage is flowing into the water body. Dumping yard exist on the spot. Court Commissioner directed BDO to clean the water body before the next inspection i.e. 20.12.2014. Nobody is present from MCD. A dry well exist inside the water body of depth about 30 feet. Case is pending in Delhi High Court. Delhi Jal Board representatives informed that STP proposal of this village is under consideration.	  28°34.521'N 36°52.026'E Alt.- 218 m




<p>2.</p> <p>G. No. 666</p>	<p><b><u>Issapur:-</u></b></p> <p><b>Kh. No. 152(9-16)</b></p> <p>It belongs to BDO. It is dry and developed by I&amp;FC. Plantation has been done (Pahari Kikkar and Neem).</p>	 <p>28°34.452'N 76°51.309'E Alt.- 206 m</p>
<p>3.</p> <p>G. No. 663</p>	<p><b><u>Issapur:-</u></b></p> <p><b>Kh. No. 150min(12-0)</b></p> <p>It belongs to BDO. Some portion of water body is wet. Large quantity of cow dung was spotted at site. Water body area is very dirty. Kikkar plants grown in the catchment area. Court Commissioner directed BDO to clean the water body and pruning should be done. Fresh plantation needs to be done.</p>	 <p>28°33.499'N 76°52.136'E Alt.- 207 m</p>

4.	<p><b><u>Issapur:-</u></b></p> <p>G. No. 664</p> <p><b>Kh. No. 151(10-9)</b></p> <p>It belongs to BDO. It is dry and large quantity of cow dung is lying at the site. Court Commissioner directed BDO to clean the water body on priority basis before the next visit which is going to be held on 20.12.2014.</p>	  <p>28°33.524'N 76°52.164'E Alt.- 208</p>
5.	<p><b><u>Issapur:-</u></b></p> <p>G. No. 662</p> <p><b>Kh. No. 149(24-8)</b></p> <p>It belongs to BDO. Various temples exist on the water body land. The temple is known as "Dada Bude". Park exists in the water body which is well maintained.</p>	   <p>28°33.609'N 76°51.923'E Alt.- 203</p>




<p>6.</p> <p>G. No. 667</p>	<p><b><u>Issapur:-</u></b></p> <p><b>Kh. No. 126 (3-7) &amp; catchment area is 3 acres approx.</b></p> <p>It belongs to BDO. It is dry and is known as Dada Dev Temple Johar under Lal Dora. Maintenance of park in catchment is in good condition. Villagers have requested to Court Commissioner to open the water pipe line from Haryana Canal. BDO to complete the survey of close water pipeline and submit the report to the Court Commissioner on an emergent basis.</p>	  <p>28°34.632'N 76°51.781'E Alt.- 198</p>

Position is not clear. Water body area is dirty and plane. SDM (Kapashera) is not present at the time of inspection.
