Site Inspection of 33 Water Bodies of Dwarka (list provided by Sh. Diwan Singh) conducted on 6.8.2016 along with Sh. Diwan Singh and DDA in Original Application No. 299 of 2016 titled as "Diwan Singh & ANR Vs. Union of India & Ors." pending in Hon'ble National Green Tribunal. Some water bodies already inspected by Court Commissioner on 9.6.2016 and 2.7.2016 and some water bodies are recorded in revenue records. Water bodies which were left were inspected on 6.8.2016. On the basis of Site Inspection detailed report is as follows:-

sludge/sewage of 100 to 125 persons which was not costly and would also not require much space for treatment of sewage of the area. He indicated that the cost of such unit would be around 6 to 8 lakhs and would be much cheaper and would utilize very less space as compared to a setup of STP Plants.

He also suggested that the said water could be reutilized/recycled for many purposes like Horticulture, Washing, Toilets etc. etc. and could also be used for recharging of underground water, if levels so permit.

The Delhi Jal Board was requested to look into the matter as well as feasibility of Stilt Chambers and to do the needful within a maximum period of three weeks.

This water body has been inspected by Court Commissioners on 09.06.2016. The observations is as follows:-

Their appeared an encroachment in the water body. DDA requested for demarcation, accordingly, Revenue Authorities were directed to carry out the demarcation on 16.06.2016 at 11.00 A.M. and all the agencies were requested to be on site for carrying out the demarcation and a report of demarcation be submitted by 20.06.2016.

The water body was dirty. The DDA was directed to clean the same within the maximum period of 2 weeks. Report be submitted to the Court Commissioner by 20.06.2016.

MCD requested that part of land of the Water Body be given for Construction of 'Dhalao'. MLA showed the MCD site near the Water Body on the opposite side, which was agreed as suitable by MCD for 'Dhalao''.

Catchment of rain water was also required and agreed upon by the MCD to construct water drains within 2 weeks.

Col. Devender Sehrawat, MLA of the area suggested MCD/DJB for small Stilt Chambers which was the latest technology and could cater sludge/sewage of 100 to 125 persons which was not costly and would also not require much space for treatment of sewage of the area.

He indicated that the cost of such unitwould be around 6 to 8 lakhs and would be much cheaper and would utilize very less space as compared to a setup of STP Plants.

He also suggested that the said water could be reutilized/recycled for many purposes like Horticulture, Washing, Toilets etc. etc. and could also be used for recharging of underground water, if levels so permit.

The Delhi Jal Board was requested to look into the matter as well as feasibility of Stilt Chambers and to do the needful within a maximum period of three weeks.

As regards rain water, no drains for rain water (Naalis) in the village which could collect the rain water and divert it to the water body found. The MCD was directed to do the needful within a period of 2 weeks so that the same could benefit this year's monsoons and also help in recharging of Ground Water.
