## Minutes of the Meeting

**Minutes of the Meeting held at 3.00 PM on 17<sup>th</sup> March, 2015 under the chairmanship of Chief Secretary, Delhi, with reference to NGT judgment dated 13-01-2015 and clarificatory directions order dated 02-03-2015 in OA No. 6/2012 and 300/2013 in the matter of Manoj Mishra Vs. Union of India and Ors.**


1. Chief Secretary referred to the meeting held by the Cabinet Secretary regarding action plan to clean Ganga. In this meeting, steps taken by DJB to treat sewage and by Industries Department to treat industrial effluents were discussed including the interceptor project of DJB. He emphasized the need to take steps to ensure that steps be taken by all Departments/Agencies in pursuance of directions of NGT to clean river Yamuna.
2. Chief Secretary was briefed about the issues of Yamuna Cleaning and Beautification referring to the directions of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal in the matter of Manoj Mishra Vs. Union of India and Ors. Secretary (E & F) informed that vide judgment dated 13-01-2015, NGT has setup a Principal Committee under Sh. Shashi Shekhar, Spl. Secretary, Ministry of Environment & Forest and Climate Change, Govt. of India to monitor time bound action of all the Departments/Agencies related to, "Mailey Se Nirmal Yamuna" Revitalization Plan-2017. He informed that meetings of Principal Committee have been held on 05-02-2015 and 23-02-2015. Thereafter, clarificatory directions were issued by NGT on 02-03-2015. Both the judgment and order were discussed in detail
3. Chief Secretary expressed displeasure over the slow pace of mapping of data of highest flood level during the last 25 years by I&FCD and desired that the Department should submit proposal based on the data already available in the Department and with the assistance of GSDL within two days. **(Action by : I&FCD/GSDL/DDA)**
4. Secretary (E & F) referred to the penalty of Rs. 50,000/- for debris dumping in flood plains and Rs. 5,000/- for immersing of Puja Material in River Yamuna, on the basis of "Polluter Pays Principle" by NGT. CS suggested that the matter be taken up by Law Department, GNCTD in consultation with Chief Legal Officer of DDA for formulating procedure/directions for proper implementation as per provisions of legislation as well as NGT judgment/order. **(Action by : Law Department/DDA, Environment Department)**





5. Representative of DDA informed about plan of installing CCTV Cameras at vulnerable points along the Yamuna Flood Plains to detect illegal debris dumping and immersion of Puja Material. A public notice has already been issued in this regard by DDA. After the flood plains are demarcated the exact position of various structures will be put up before the Principal Committee. **(Action by : DDA and all concerned Agencies)**
6. CS directed DJB to submit within two days time, a note as to how it can implement NGT orders along with its current projects/schemes, financial resources, challenges and time required to complete these projects. The points, on which review of NGT order is required, be also listed out. **(Action by : DJB)**
7. The absence of Senior Officer of Industries Department was noted. CS sought information about the status of water polluting units in residential and non-conforming areas from Industries Department/ DDA/ MCDs/DPCC and the concerned land owning agency within two days. He also asked Industries and Environment Departments as to how these industrial units were disposing industrial effluents in drains and desired immediate action from the all concerned. **(Action by : Industries Department/DSI IDC/DDA/ MCDs/DPCC)**
8. Industries Department, GNCTD in consultation with DDA shall submit an action plan in respect of treatment of effluents from the 22 Re-development areas notified by MoUD, GoI. CS directed DSI IDC to submit detailed plan about treatment of effluents pertaining to the remaining 11 industrial areas within two days. **(Action by : Industries Department/DSI IDC/DDA/DPCC)**
9. DSI IDC and Department of Industries to make rapid assessment of requirement of CETPs in industry located in residential areas and unauthorized colonies not connected to any CETP at present and suggest steps for their treatment. In this regard, the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 07-05-2004 relating to functioning of industries in residential areas of Delhi need to be followed. **(Action by : Industries Department/DSI IDC/DDA/ MCDs/DPCC)**
10. CS desired that the entire issue be coordinated by Environment Department as it is a case of degradation of Riverine Eco System, which needs to be rehabilitated.
