- On 10th October, 2012 "The Hon'ble Supreme Court then proceeded to pass certain directions, with the hope that the authorities would take adequate and appropriate steps to attain the object of making Yamuna clean and healthy".
- Petitioners, approached various concerned Agencies for appropriate actions in Nov. and Dec. 2011 failing which they approached NGT. Failure as part of Fundamental duty under Art 48 A and 51 A(g) the Constitution applicants prayed before NGT under section 15 of NGT Act 2010 for reconstitution of Environment and ecology of the river bed and making Yamuna Pollution Free.

ACTIONS ALREADY TAKEN

- Identified areas generating Solid/Building Waste.
- Created STF for patrolling such areas.
- Removed dumped soil and debris (solid as well as organic),
- Notice issued for temporary duping sites.
- Barricading and Gates erected at Entry Points to Yamuna.
- Warning Sign Boards against dumping of Malba and Debris at various sites along Yamuna.
- Yamuna River Flood Development (YRFD) Plan of DDA shared with other Agencies.
- "Polluter Pay Principal" invoked by NGT of Rs. 5 Lakhs compensation for dumping waste in Yamuna and destroying its environment.
